

International calling. How to make an international telephone call.

This document provides a simple step-by-step guide on how to make international phone calls.

4 simple steps to make an international call

1. Before making the call, first dial the IDD number (International Direct Dialing Number). This can be found on the other document in this series; see International Direct Dialing Number codes. Different countries may have different numbers, or indeed, have more than one IDD depending on the carrier, type of service and geographical location.
2. Next, dial the country code of the country you are trying to call. This can be found on the other document in this series; see International Country Calling codes.
3. Finally, dial the city / area code, if appropriate, for the number you are dialing. Please note: smaller countries may not use city or area codes.
4. Now you have enabled the phone to connect to an international line, now dial the telephone number of the person you are trying to call.
